

THE MARCH

Heritage of Pride's March Committee relies heavily on volunteers and community organizations to staff various activities at The March.

All organizations approved for any of the working grant positions at The March must send all their volunteers required (see descriptions below) to one of two training sessions. These sessions will take place in Manhattan. Location, time and date TBA.

All jobs are located either in the March formation area or along the route.

All jobs will take place on Sunday, June 26th, for the March.

In all cases, those staffing any of these areas must wear official HOP volunteer shirts and credentials, which will be provided by HOP.

Organizations applying for the "Ribbons of Remembrance Working Grant" must be an AIDS service organization (ASO). Any and all organizations can apply for any of the other grants.

The March takes place on Sunday, June 26, 2011. Step-off is precisely at noon. There will be 2 Moments of silence is at 1 and 3 PM.

Those staffing this area must wear official HOP volunteer shirts, which will be provided by HOP.

| <p>Ribbons of Remembrance Working Grant The staffing of the <i>Ribbons of Remembrance</i> at the <i>We Remember</i> Banner.</p> <p>The organization chosen for this working grant will receive 50% of the funds its members collect from donations given for these ribbons during the March but no less than \$1000.</p> <p>The <i>Ribbons of Remembrance</i> are an important part of the <i>Moment of Silence</i>. Many of us carry these ribbons and inscribe them with the names of those we've lost to AIDS. Through donations made for the ribbons, Heritage of Pride has raised and donated over \$50,000 for various AIDS organizations. Your organization may have been a recipient of one of these donations. | <p>Formation Area Vehicle Coordinators</p> <p>Positions Available Providing security checks for vehicles entering the formation area.</p> <p>Number of Volunteers 12 to 15 total with one or two located at various intersections in the formation area.</p> <p>Time Commitment 9:00 AM until approximately 12:30PM</p> <p>Group Responsibilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ On each block of the formation area, checking each vehicle as it attempts to enter the area. EVERY vehicle must have a permit. ▪ Working with Section Leaders to insure that vehicles are lined up in the proper order. ▪ This is a relatively brief job insuring better security for all involved. Proper enforcement is critical to effective management of The March. This means each person must be trained and clearly understand the rules to be enforced. ▪ Unless your group is at the very front of The March, you will be able to join your group in The March. <p>The Organization chosen for this job will receive a grant of \$1,000.</p> | <p>March Route Coordinators</p> <p>Positions Available Staffing four areas along The March route: two above 14th Street and two below.</p> <p>Number of Volunteers 10 to 12 per area. 2 each at an assigned intersection.</p> <p>Time Commitment 11:30 AM until approximately 5:30 PM</p> <p>Group Responsibilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Understanding clearly the nature of the job and your role in helping the March committee manage the issues that contribute to delays along The March route. ▪ <u>During The March:</u> Working with both the NYPD and the groups to insure that the March keeps moving and that gaps are closed. ▪ <u>After the event:</u> Helping HOP's volunteer staff do the breakdown of the various sites along the route or helping with dispersal. <p>Each organization staffing one of the areas along The March route will receive a grant of \$1,000.</p> |
